Class 44 - EASY FRUIT CAKE

Ingredients

8 oz Self-Raising Flour
¼ Teaspoon Salt
4 oz Butter
4 oz Castor Sugar
2 Medium Sized Eggs
Fruit (raisins, currants & sultanas)
Little Grated Orange Rind
Scant ¼ Pint Milk

Directions

1. Sift flour and salt
2. Cream butter and sugar together
3. Add eggs, one at a time, and beat well
4. Fold in flour, gradually 8 oz Mixed add fruit and orange rind
5. Gradually add milk
6. Bake in a tin of any size or shape at Gas mark 2 - 3, 300° - 325°F, 150° - 160°C, for approx 1½ – 2 hours

Class 45 - VICTORIA SANDWICH

Ingredients

6 oz Self Raising Flour
Pinch Salt
6 oz Butter or Margarine
6 oz Castor Sugar
3 Eggs
Jam for Filling

Directions

1. Sift flour and salt
2. Cream fat and sugar until light and fluffy
3. Beat in eggs, one at a time
4. Fold in dry ingredients with a metal spoon
5. Divide mixture equally into two well-greased 7"-8", round sandwich tins
6. Bake in the centre of oven at Gas mark 4, 350°F, 180°C, for 25 - 30 minutes

Class 46 - RICH SHORTBREAD

Ingredients

9 oz Plain Flour
3 oz Castor Sugar
6 oz Butter

Directions

1. Mix flour and sugar in a bowl
2. Rub in butter
3. Knead well to form a smooth paste
4. Divide into equal parts, shape and flatten into two rounds
5. Mark top in portions, prick with a fork
6. Place on a greased baking sheet. Bake in a moderate oven, Gas mark 3 - 4, 325° - 350°F, 160° - 180°C, for 25 - 30 minutes until pale golden colour

MEN ONLY

Class 47 - MARY BERRY'S LEMON DRIZZLE TRAYBAKE

Ingredients:

225g (8 oz) softened butter,
225g (8 oz) caster sugar,
275g (10 oz) sifted self-raising flour,
2 teaspoons baking powder,
4 eggs,
4 tablespoons milk,
finely grated rind of 2 lemons.
A traybake or roasting tin 30 x 23 x 4 cm
(12 x 9 x 1 ½ inches)

Crunchy Topping

175g (6 oz) granulated sugar,
juice of 2 lemons.

Directions:

Cut a rectangle of baking paper to fit the base and sides of the tin. Grease the tin and then line with the paper. Pre-heat the oven to 160°C/325°F/Gas 3. Measure all the ingredients for the traybake into a large bowl and beat well for about 2 minutes until well blended. Turn the mixture into the prepared tin, level the top gently with the back of the spatula. Bake in the middle of the pre-heated oven for about 35-40 minutes or until the traybake springs back when pressed lightly with a finger in the centre and is beginning to shrink away from the sides of the tin. Allow to cool in the tin for a few minutes, lift out & remove the paper putting the traybake onto a wire rack. Mix the lemon juice and granulated sugar in a small bowl to give a runny consistency. Spoon evenly over the traybake whilst it is still just warm. Cut into squares when cold.
