No puppies under 6 months old to be entered.

Dogs do not need to be Kennel Club Registered for any of the classes.

Dogs that have been awarded a Challenge Certificate, Reserve Challenge Certificate, Show Certificate of Merit or Junior Warrant are not eligible for entry at Companion Dog Shows.

**Dogs are shown at owners risk and must be kept on a lead at all times**

**Please clean up after your dog!**

### **Covid – 19 Rules**

The committee will ensure to the best of its ability that the event is run to Covid safe guidelines. It is your responsibility to ensure you comply to national and local restrictions in the interest of the safety of all participants. If a competitor, or anyone in their household, has Covid -19 related symptoms or has tested positive for Covid -19, the competitor MUST NOT attend our dog show. (Continued overleaf).

## **Covid – 19 Rules - continued**

The judging for the Pedigree and Novelty classes will be held in one show ring consecutively. There will be an 'In and Out' exit to the show ring. If there are more than 10 entries per class, it will be judged in separate batches to avoid bottleneck areas in the show ring. The steward/show organiser will announce each class and call the participants accordingly in plenty of time to enter the show ring. Only enter when your number is called (no queuing or gathering at the show ringside). On entering the show ring all participants must ensure that they wear a face covering and remain socially distanced from others within the show ring. In the Pedigree section the judge will assess the conformation of the dog visually together with the movement. The handler will show the dogs teeth to the judge. The judge will not make hand contact with the dogs.

No chairs will be provided, bring your own chairs - no seating ringside or gathering.

**ON ATTENDING OUR DOG SHOW YOU ARE AGREEING TO ABIDE BY THE ABOVE RULES, AND DO SO AT YOUR OWN RISK. ANYONE NOT ABIDING BY THESE RULES WILL BE ASKED TO LEAVE.**
